
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Conclusion, recommendations and scaleup:

- The skyrocketing amount of untreatable menstrual waste generated requires attention. Especially, in resource-poor settings where inconsistent treatment standards and lack of treatment infrastructure exists. Understanding the behavioural triggers that dictate the irresponsible disposal of menstrual waste must be identified. Inducing behavioural change among the population can be effectively used to curb the amount of waste generated. Often, the users (here the menstruators) are often to be blamed for resorting to incorrect ways of menstrual waste disposal.
- however, failure to comprehend the hidden behavioral triggers that run across the population will ultimately result in a frail and futile intervention strategy.
