Over 235 participants attended, including Gram Sevaks, Sarpanchs, Deputy Sarpanchs, CRPs, and SHG members from various Gram Panchayats.

8th March 2025 | Palghar



On Women's Day, celebrations were organized at Ranshet and Ganjad Gram Panchayats, bringing together 195 participants, including SHG members, the Sarpanch, Gram Sevak, and GP members. The event featured IEC activities on rainwater harvesting and plastic waste management, followed by an oath-taking ceremony to promote sustainable solid waste practices.

Enhancement of Water Supply System

March 2025 | Palghar



The water supply system in Panshetpada-2, Mahagaon Gram Panchayat, Palghar, was upgraded through a Mini Piped Water Supply Scheme benefiting 52 households. A solar pump now delivers water from a 40-feet deep well to a 5,000-liter overhead tank, easing the burden on women and children who previously traveled far to fetch water.











Construction of New Well

March 2025 | Palghar



A new well was constructed in Ozarpada, Ranshet Gram Panchayat, providing a reliable water source for 67 Katkari tribal households. Earlier, residents walked 1.5 km daily, spending hours fetching water as handpumps dried up by April. The well has resolved water scarcity, and a solar motor pump installed by the Gram Panchayat now ensures continuous supply to the community tap.









RWH at Community and Institutional Level

March 2025 | Palghar









As part of the initiative, 24 community-level and 9 institutional Rainwater Harvesting (RWH) structures were implemented. With active community participation through shramdan and resource mobilization, the effort ensured local ownership. School-based RWH systems not only meet institutional water needs but also serve as models for wider adoption.







December 2024 | Palghar



An IEC awareness campaign was conducted across villages in Dahanu Block, engaging over 30 participants, including students, teachers and representatives from Gram Panchayat. The sessions focused on raising awareness about Rainwater Harvesting (RWH) at both community and institutional levels.
