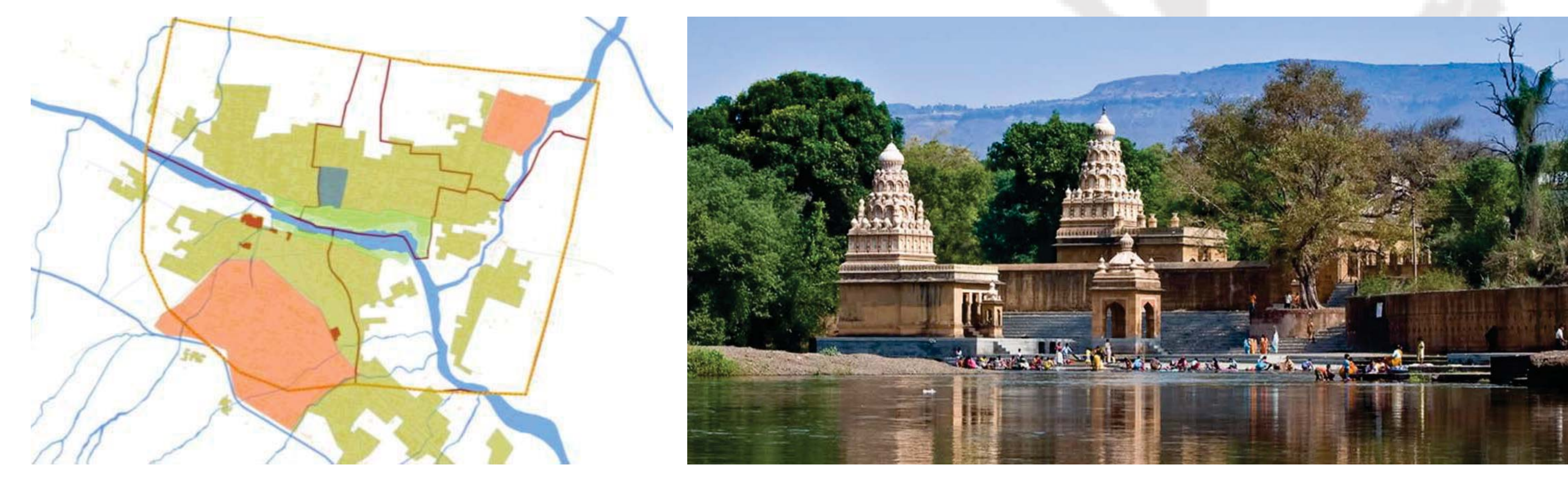


City Sanitation Planning in Wai

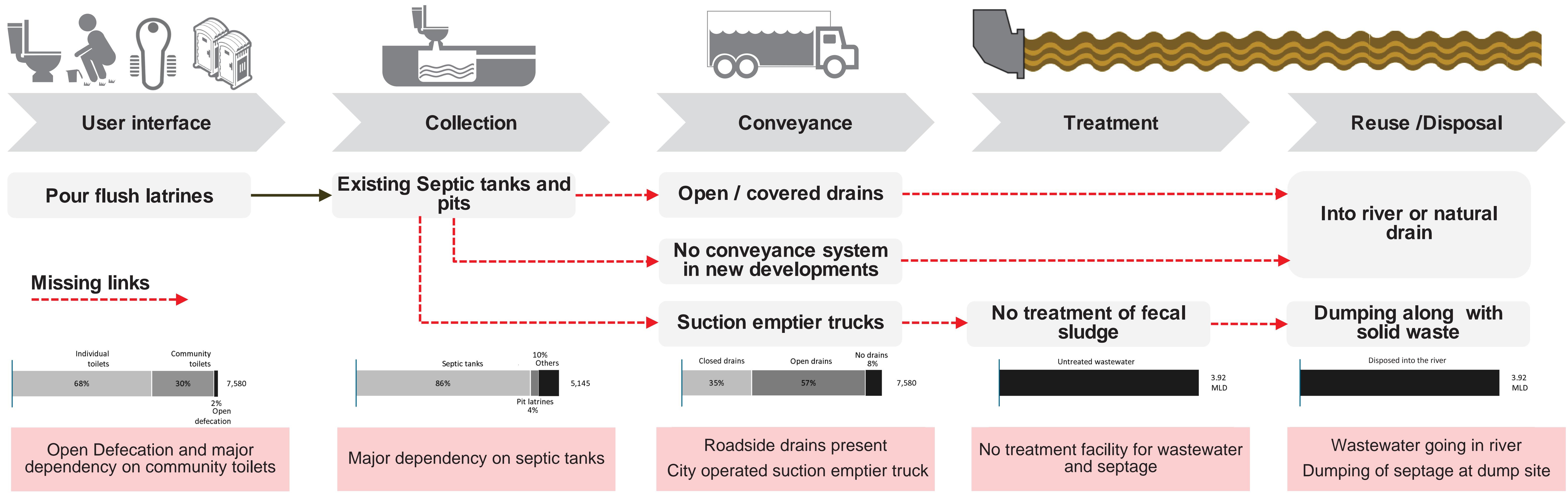
Wai

- Around 6% of the population living in slums



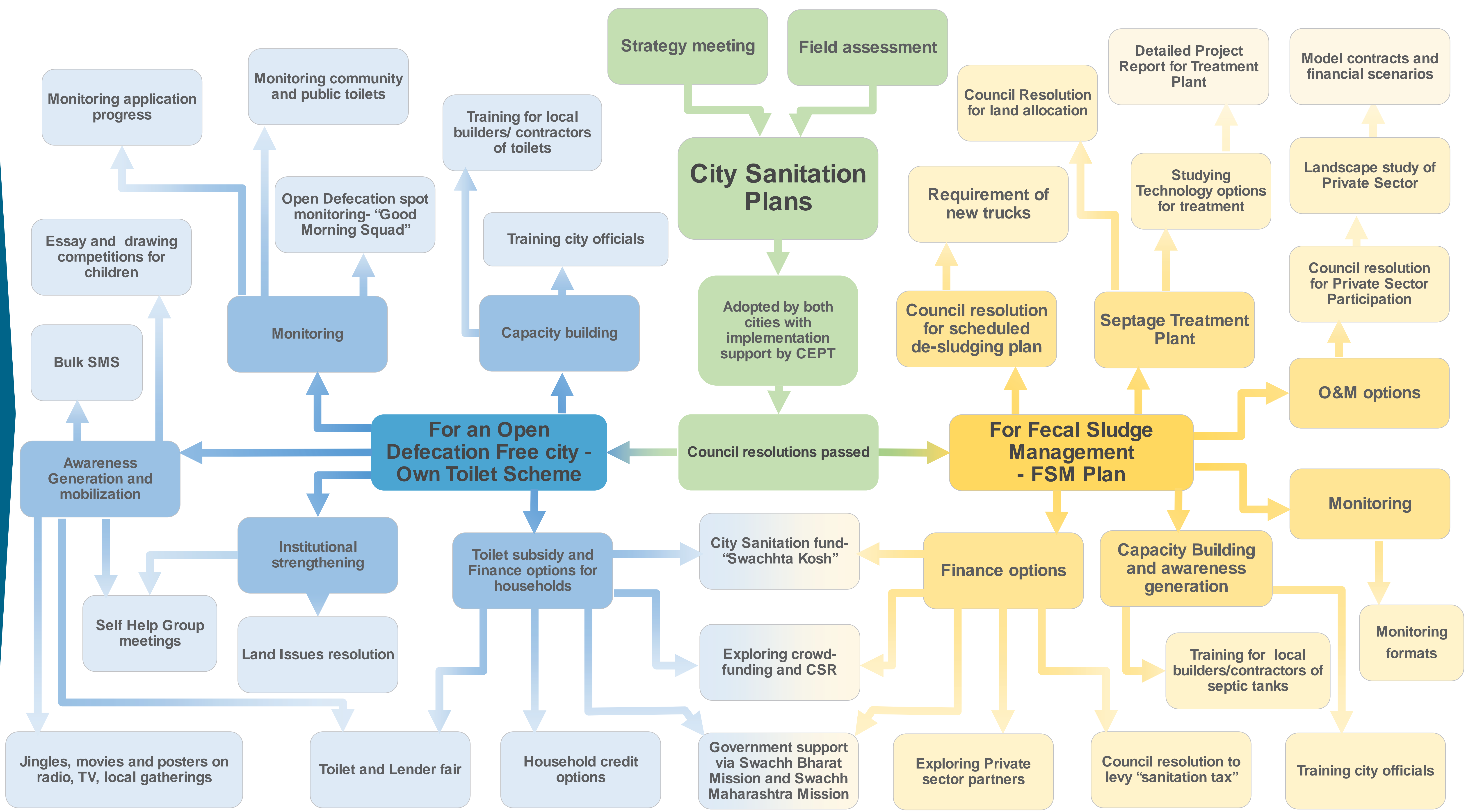
