#### Availing of Performance grants

- The release of Performance grants to the ULB the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission (FFC) has suggested that ULBs has to fulfil the following conditions.
- Making available data on local bodies receipt and expenditure through audited accounts.
- Improvement in own revenues; and
- Measure and publish service level benchmarks (SLB) for basic services.

#### Availing of performance grant

- The Commissioner & Director of Municipal Administration, Hyderabad has entered an MoU with CEPT, University, Hyderabad to carry out the following activities.
  - Implementation of online SLB-PAS module
  - Integrate SLB-PAS system in existing e-governance system in pilot cities
  - City Support for preparation of service level improvement plans

- The CEPT University, Ahmedabad has trained the Municipal Commissioners of Urban Local Bodies for the last three years i.e., during the year 2015–16, 2016–17 and 2017–18.
- The SLB data was uploaded on <a href="www.pas.org.in">www.pas.org.in</a> and individual logins were given to the Municipal Commissioners to monitor their service levels
