
Objective of the exercise



- Schools have very low Cleaning Frequency



- Implementing **daily maintenance system** (format for daily activity to be filled by the worker) and monitored by the administration
- ULB can monitor sanitation services in Public and Private Schools- through Independent Private Agency
- School Inspection by Block Development Officer, Dept. of Education
- Complaint redressal system to be set up in schools, which is monitored by PTA/ ULB

*School facilities: School campus is well equipped with basic facilities such as playground, compound wall, toilets, class rooms with lights and fans, dustbins, etc but no chairs and benches. As school is conducted in two shifts the facilities are adequate.

Sanitation Facilities:



*Common toilet facility for girls' and boys, as boys' toilet is under construction.



*Staff toilet located near staff room

Toilet Facility: They have common toilet facility for boys and girls i.e. they are using girls' toilets as boys' toilet is under construction. The toilets are designed child friendly. Toilets have proper doors, ventilators, lights, etc. There are buckets and taps in each toilet for water supply. The urinals have self cleaning facility but need to be refurbished. Provision of separate basins outside toilet for washing hands. No soaps or hand washes kept as children do not use it properly. The facilities provided by government are not adequate.

There is a separate toilet for staff located in the staff room. It is equipped with taps and buckets with proper water supply. The toilets are connected to the septic tanks, which outlets are let to the main drainage line.

Other Facilities:



*Ramps, aquaguards for drinking water, ventilators, windows, lights fans, etc. taps & buckets in toilets

Observations:

Water Supply: Nagar Palika water connection in taps is used for drinking purposes. Aquaguard used to purify water. 750 liters tank used to store drinking water. Bore water used for toilet use. 5000 liters overhead tank to store this water. There are separate wash basins (3 taps). The present water supply is sufficient for both purposes.

Maintenance: The school administration has appointed a worker for cleaning and maintenance of the sanitary facilities in the school. The toilets are cleaned daily once in a day every morning. Dustbins are provided in each classrooms. Daily the waste is collected by the municipality van. Sometimes they dump in the nearby municipality bin.
