






Step wise progress







Launched four handbooks on 13th Oct 16... on ODF, Sustainability and Septage Management









Maharashtra- 1st in Swachh Bharat Mission,

- 1. To develop a systematic approach and a concept of "ODF cities"
- 2. To declare 19 ODF cities on 2nd Oct 15
- 3. To develop mechanism for validation of ODF cities
- 4. To develop an idea of incentive scheme, linked to sustainability
- 5. To develop concepts of ODF+ and ODF ++ cities
- 6. To declare 52 ODF cities in February 16
- 7. To declare 100 ODF cities in August 16
- 8. To have 54, highest number of cities validated by QCI in Oct 16
- 9. To have city, Pune, with highest number (23000) of toilets constructed, in the country
- 10. To launch a compost brand- "Harit"
- 11. To have achieved and celebrated third milestone of the mission!!
