# Water Governance definition

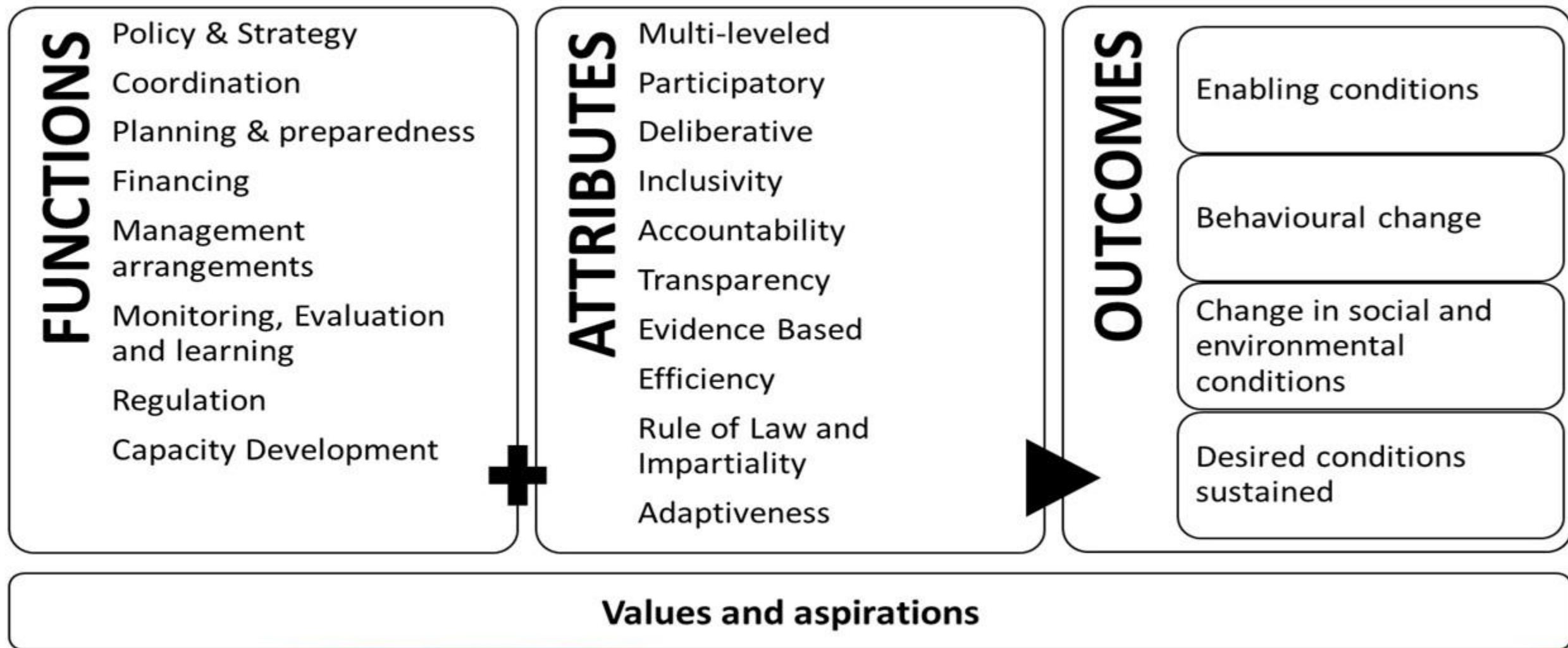
Water governance refers to the range of **political, social, economic and administrative systems** that are in place to develop and manage water resources, and the **delivery of water services, at different levels of the society**

Water governance is the **set of rules, practices, and processes** through which decisions for the management of water resources and services are taken and implemented, and decision-makers are held accountable

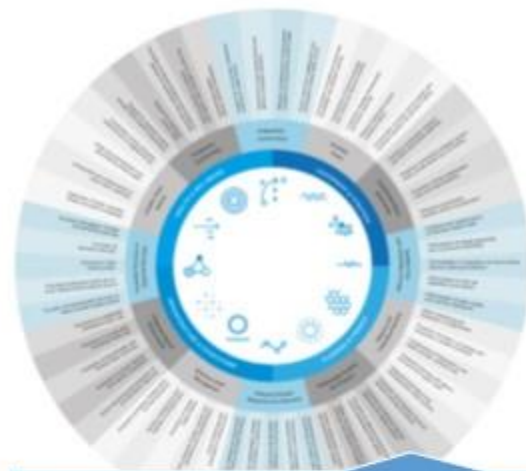
