

SLB-PAS in Maharashtra – journey of 10 years

PAS Project initiated in Maharashtra from 2009 by CEPT, Ahmedabad and AIILSG, Mumbai, in collaboration with UDD, WSSD and DMA, GoM –

- One of the first two States in the country to have adopted PAS-SLB, even before they became the 13th /14th FC requirements – in order to mainstream SLBs within ULB functioning
- Performance measurement through online portal and preparation of SLB Gazette for 13th and 14th FC – initiated and led by UDD and DMA, GoM, facilitated by CEPT and AIILSG
- Online database on UWSS for all ULBs, for last 10 years being linked to/ used / referred under various urban development missions and programmes
- Not limited to performance measurement, but extended to performance monitoring and improvement- city (CSPs, PIPs) and State level support

From 'no data' to 'organised data' on the portal


- In initial years centralised or decentralised data submission workshops conducted at AIILSG, Mumbai
- 2010- workshops in the DMA office- status reviewed daily by the Director, DMA
- Now ULBs submit their data from their officesrequired support provided by PAS team
- Progress is reviewed and monitored by DMA,
 UDD
- SLB Gazette published every year under 13th and 14th FC.
- CAG refers to PAS database for municipal audits
- SLB Gazette for 2018-19 under process

Data driven initiatives for monitoring and development

- Municipal corporations like Navi Mumbai, Pimpri- Chinchwad,
 Pune have developed city level information and monitoring systems to operate and monitor various urban services
- First City Data Officer in Pune under 'City Data for India' initiative - under Smart City Mission- to tap the potential of municipal datasets and drive data driven decision making
- Municipal councils like Malkapur, Shirpur Waravde have adopted online monitoring of services
- Monitoring of Government schemes/income-expenditure in municipal councils through DMA's web portal

Data driven initiatives for monitoring and development

- Every ULB has its own web portal accounts, budgets, scheme details to be uploaded
- Maharashtra Jeevan Pradhikaran's schemes are monitored through MJP's web portal- linked to MAINet
- Paperless districts- Sindhudurga district's initiative
- BPMS, Online property and water tax payments and online RTS services
- PAS to be integrated with SCADA system being implemented under Maharashtra Suvarn Jayanti Nagarotthan Yojana (a State level scheme)
